

DISCIPLINARY CODE OF INFRACTIONS AND CONSEQUENCES

Atrocious/Group Assault:	Minimum of Ten (10) days Out of School suspension up to and possibly including one full school year pending BOE action, Activity restriction, Administrative Review, Possible BOE action- readmission process may include change of placement
Automobiles	First offense: Warning about towing (cling tag), parent contact Second offense: Warning about towing (cling tag), One After School Detention, parent contact Third offense: Towing at owner's expense, Two After School Detentions, and parent contact Fourth Offense: Progressive discipline Administrative Discretion
Cafeteria	Late to cafeteria, purchasing food or beverages outside of your lunch period, and/or cutting in the lunch line may result in one After School Detention Misbehavior in the cafeteria area and/or throwing food or trash, or leaving trash or littering will result in student being assigned a minimum of, but not limited to, one After School Detention. Students with 3 or more disciplinary infractions during lunch time may be assigned a mandatory designated area to eat lunch.
Gambling	Minimum of, but not limited to, After School Detention(s)
Communication/ Electronic Devices	First Offense: Warning Second Offense: Minimum of, but not limited to, After School Detention(s), items confiscated, and/ or parent retrieval. Maximum Out of school suspension(s)/parent conference 3 or more infractions may include loss of privileges During non-instructional times, Cell phone use is permissible during lunch in the cafeteria and between classes. *Students may not be in possession of speakers while on campus. If so, speakers may be confiscated and held by the Assistant Principal for 30 days or until a parent picks them up. Students may only use one earbud while on school grounds.
Recording of Disorderly Conduct	Minimum of, but not limited to, Saturday Detention(s) maximum Out- of -School Suspension(s) Possible complaints filed with MTPD
Conduct Impeding an Investigation	Minimum of, but not limited to, After School Detention(s) *includes refusing to identify oneself
THREATS/ ABUSIVE LANGUAGE/ INTIMIDATION/ GANG-RELATED/ EXCESSIVE HORSEPLAY/ CONDUCT POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS TO ONE'S SELF OR OTHERS	Minimum, but not limited to, one Saturday Detention Maximum 10 days out-of-school suspension/parent conference Complaint may be filed with the MTPD
Dress Code: Failure to Comply	Students who refuse to change or have more than one offense, will receive a Minimum of, but not limited to, an administrative warning(s). MULTIPLE OFFENSES - Students will be required, to meet the administrator with their parent/guardian and, subsequently for additional offenses, with the principal, superintendent and ultimately the Board of Education.

Failure to Comply with Search and Seizures	<p>All students, as well as their belongings, lockers, and vehicles, are subject to simple search performed by administration or security in the interests of school safety, security, and wellbeing. Any student refusing to comply with search and seizure procedures will be issued discipline as an admission of guilt, receiving a 10 day out-of-school suspension.</p>
Failure to Follow Procedure/ Misconduct	<p>Minimum of, but not limited to, one (1) After School Detention</p>
Disruptive Behavior	<p>Minimum of, but not limited to, two (2) After School Detentions</p>
False Alarm/ Tampering with Alarms	<p>First and Second Offense: Four days Out of School Suspension, Restitution, Possible Charges filed with MTPD Third Offense: Ten days Out of School Suspension, Restitution, Principal Review, Possible Charges filed with MTPD Additional Offense(s): Ten days Out of School Suspension, Restitution, BOE Review, Possible Charges filed with MTPD</p>
Fighting/ Inciting a Fight	<p>First Offense: 4 day out-of-school suspension, possible complaint filed with the MTPD, Behavior Contract Second Offense: 10 day out-of-school suspension, possible complaint filed with the MTPD, Behavior Contract Third Offense: 10 day out-of-school suspension, possible complaint filed with the MTPD, Principal Review, Behavior Contract Additional Offenses: 10 day out-of-school suspension, possible complaint filed with the MTPD, BOE Review, Behavior Contract</p>
Fireworks/ Explosive Devices	<p>Suspensions will be issued and complaints may be signed with the MTPD. Ten days out of School Suspension, BOE Review.</p>
Forgery/ Cheating/ Plagiarism	<p>First Offense: One (1) Saturday Detention Second Offense: One (1) day of in school suspension Third Offense: Two (2) days of in school suspension Additional Offenses: Three (3) days of out of school suspension</p>
Defacing/ Destruction of School Property	<p>Minimum of a Saturday Detention maximum of 4 days out of school suspension for damage under \$25 Minimum 3 days out of school suspension maximum of 10 day out-of-school suspension for damage over \$25 Arrest and complaints may be filed with the MTPD. Restitution is expected Possible Principal and/or BOE Review</p>
Disrespect/ Defiance	<p>Minimum of, but not limited to, one (1) Saturday Detention. Maximum of ten (10) days out of school suspension/parent conference.</p>
Illegal Absence/ Not Reporting to Class Any illegal absence will result in a "0" in that class. Work cannot be made up.	<p>First Offense: Saturday Detention and written notification Second Offense: One (1) day In School Suspension and written notification Third Offense: Two (2) days In School Suspension and Parent contact Four or More Offenses: Minimum of three (3) days in-school suspension and loss of credit for the school year or <i>mandatory</i> credit completion</p>
Obscene or Inappropriate Comments/ Gestures/ Drawings/ Touching/ Profanity towards Students	<p>Minimum of, but not limited to, one (1) Administrative Detention. Maximum of ten (10) days out of school suspension/parent conference. Possible complaint may be filed with the MTPD.</p>

Inappropriate Display of Affection/ Sexual Misconduct	Minimum of, but not limited to, an Administrative Warning. Maximum of 10 days out-of-school suspension/parent conference. Possible complaint may be filed with the MTPD.
Lateness to Class	1 st - 4 th late to class= Warning 5 - 15 lates to class= Minimum of, but not limited to, one After School Detention. A parent conference with an Administrator may be required. 15- 20 lates to class = One (1) day Saturday detention 21 or more late to class=Administrator's discretion Note: This is a running total for each course.
Late to School Students must sign in at the main office upon arrival to school after the 1 st block late bell rings (7:40 am).	1 st - 4 th late to school= Warning 5 - 15 lates to school= Minimum of, but not limited to, one After School Detention. A parent conference with an Administrator may be required. 15- 20 lates to school = One (1) day Saturday detention 21 or more late to school =Administrator's discretion Note: This is a running total for the entire year.
Leaving Class without Permission/ Removal from Class	Minimum of, but not limited to, two (2) After School Detentions
Misuse of Hall Pass	First Offense: Minimum of, but not limited to, one (1)After School Detention. * Second Offense: Minimum of, but not limited to, two (2) After School Detentions. * Third Offense: Minimum of, but not limited to, one (1) Saturday Detention. * <i>*Hall pass restriction may also be assigned.</i>
Profanity	First Offense:Minimum of, but not limited to, one (1) After School Detentions Second Offense:Minimum of, but not limited to, two (2) After School Detentions. Additional offenses: Administrator discretion
Racial/ Hateful/ Ethnic Slurs of Inflammatory Comments	Minimum of, but not limited to, a saturday detention.
Removal from Saturday Detention	Minimum of, but not limited to, two (2) days in-school suspension
Use of Tobacco Products	First Offense: Four (4) day out-of-school suspension and mandatory meeting the guidance counselor. Second Offense: Four (4) day out-of-school suspension, parent conference, and a charges may be filed with MTPD. Third Offense or more: Four (4) day out-of-school suspension, parent conference, and a formal complaint will be filed with the MTPD.
Possession of Tobacco Products	Students will be issued a minimum of but not limited to One (1) Saturday Detention and mandatory meeting with the guidance counselor.
Theft: <u>Minor: Under \$25</u>	First Offense: Two (2) days out of school suspension, possible charges files, and restitution. Second Offense: Four (4) days out of school suspension, possible charges files, and restitution. Third Offense or more: Ten (10) days out of school suspension, possible charges files, and restitution.
Theft: <u>Major: Over \$25</u>	First Offense: Four (4) days out of school suspension, possible charges files, and restitution. Second Offense or more: Ten (10) days out of school suspension, possible charges files, restitution, and Possible BOE Review
Truancy/ Leaving School without Permission	First Offense : Two (2) Saturday detentions Second Offense: Two (2) days in school suspension Third Offense: Two (2) days out of school suspensions, possible charges filed Three or more offenses: Three (3) days out of school suspensions and possible charges filed.

Unauthorized Area	First Offense: One (1) Saturday Detention Second Offense: Two (2) Days in school suspension Third and Additional Offense: Two (2) days out of school suspension
Unserved After School Detention	First Offense: Two (2) After School Detentions Second Offense: One (1) Saturday Detention Third Offense: One (1) days In School suspension Four or more offenses: Two (2) days in school suspension
Unserved Saturday Detention	Minimum of one (1) day in-school suspension which includes activity restriction for the day served. 4 or more offenses: Minimum of two (2) days in-school suspension which includes activity restriction for the day served.
Unserved Teacher Detention	First & Second Offense: After School Detention equal to number of Teacher detentions Third Offense: One (1) Saturday Detention Additional Offenses: One (1) day In school suspension
Unacceptable Language, Abusive Conduct, and/or Gestures directed at a Staff Member	First Offense: Three (3) days out-of-school suspension. Second Offense: Five (5) days out-of-school suspension. Third Offense: Ten (10) days out-of-school suspension and a Principal Review. Additional Offenses: Ten (10) days out-of-school suspension and a BOE review
Vandalism	Minimum of one (1) Saturday Detention and up to a maximum of a ten (10) day out-of-school suspension. Parents will be held financially responsible for damages. Local authorities may also be contacted depending upon the severity of the vandalism.
For Acts Deemed as Lewd Conduct or student is in possession of pornographic material	Minimum but not limited to Four (4) day out of school suspension and possible charges filed. Additional Offenses: Up to one full school year pending BOE action, Activity restriction, Administrative Review, BOE action- readmission process
Violence, Aggressive Acts, and/or Threats Directed towards a Staff Member	Up to one full school year pending BOE action, Activity restriction, Administrative Review, BOE action- readmission process
Weapons/ Potentially Dangerous Objects/ Look Alike	Up to one full school year pending BOE action, Activity restriction, Administrative Review, BOE action- readmission process, and a complaint will be filed with MTPD
Terrorist/ Bomb Threats/ Extortion	Up to one full school year pending BOE action, Activity restriction, Administrative Review, BOE action- readmission process
