Dear Middle Township Families,

This letter is to inform you that 2 adult individuals from Elementary No. 1 have tested positive from Covid-19. The cases are unrelated. If your child was in one of the particular classrooms, you were notified by school officials. Our school district is coordinating closely with state and local health departments and CDC in order to assure the health and safety of our community.

In response to the positive Covid-19 cases, the Middle Township School District is doing the following:

1. Cleaning and disinfecting of all exposed areas
2. Quarantining of positive and exposed individuals

We understand the level of concern regarding COVID-19. We encourage parents and students to continue following the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention promoted safeguards such as:

- Stay home when sick
- Wash hands often with soap for at least 20 seconds
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Wear a face mask while in school and on the bus
- Practice social distancing
- Limit close contact with people who are sick
- Do not share food, drinks or utensils
- Continue to monitor your health for symptoms

Please continue to monitor your children and family members for symptoms of Covid-19 and seek the appropriate medical attention if necessary. While this news is concerning for all of us, I remain thankful for those of you who continue to take the time to do your part in keeping the community safe and healthy.
