Application Process

Application Located on Middle Township High School's Homepage on March 15.

1. Application due- May 8, 2020
 - a. Including Teacher Recommendations & Transcripts
2. Committee review- May 11 - May 19
3. Acceptance letters sent- May 20, 2020
4. Commitment to the program- May 25
5. Applications will be reviewed using multiple measures by the Dual Credit Program Review Committee including transcripts.
6. ***Students will map out curriculum with ACCC Advisor***
