Dear Parent/Guardian:

Last month, the College Board announced significant modifications to the 2021 AP Exam Schedule and testing format as there are three [testing windows](#). These windows all have specific parameters regarding dates, times, and testing mode for each subject area.

School districts across the country will handle the AP administration in a multitude of ways. After careful consideration, we have decided to proceed in a manner that will allow our students and families to choose a path that best suits their individual needs. Middle Township High School will host paper and pencil exams in May. All students who elect to take a digital exam will do so at home except for AP Computer Science A and AP Computer Science Principles which will be offered digitally at home or school. It is important to note that AP French Language and AP Spanish Language will only be offered on paper in school. Below is a chart of when we will offer the paper and digital exams in each subject. All students will be scheduled for the paper exam on the date listed. If a student does not sit for the paper exam, he/she will then be moved to the next digital exam window at home.

## **Paper Exam Considerations:**

Middle Township is offering paper/pencil exams during testing window 1 or 2 depending on the exam. Most paper exams will be held during window 1 (first two weeks of May/traditional AP exam window); however, there will be some paper/pencil exams that are also offered during testing window 2 that we will offer to allow for more time to prepare as requested by many students and teachers. These tests will be offered in person at the high school. Paper exams will be full-length (3 hour) exams covering the knowledge and skills outlined in the College Board AP course syllabi.

## **Digital Exam Considerations:**

Students choosing to take a digital exam will take them at home. Exams can be taken on a desktop, laptop, or the school-issued Chromebook. They cannot be taken on smartphones. To ensure test security, students will not be allowed to return to answered questions or move back and forth between unanswered questions. Additionally, digital exams will not include questions that can be answered with internet searches, textbooks or notes, and student responses will be reviewed with plagiarism detection software and by post exam analysis.
