



Middle Township Middle School Chapter

Selection Criteria:

1. All students who have a B+ average or higher, by the end of the second marking period of seventh grade year are invited to fill out an information packet.
2. A list is made of all students who fill out the information forms and is circulated to the faculty. This is to ascertain if there is a character issue with an students that would prohibit acceptance into the NJHS.
3. The discipline records of students are checked.
4. Advisors rate the participation of students in their activities. Students who participate in out-of-school service activities (community service) obtain forms to verify their participation.
5. Information forms are compiled, with all names whited out. All consideration of the students is now blind.
6. The five member Selection committee deliberates on the information in the packets as to evidence of service to the school and community, as well as leadership. Most emphasis is placed on activities within the school as the NJHS is a school based organization. One hundred percent of the activities from sixth and seventh grade are considered.
7. Based on the evidence presented on the information forms and gathered from faculty and advisors, the committee recommends the new members. At no time do members of the committee know the names of the students. The advisor to the National Junior Honor Society is never part of the selection committee.
